And so the title, In Geneva No One Can Hear You Scream, was born out of a deep affection for Switzerland and the desire to produce a provocative exhibition in what is thought to be a neutral, democratic society.

A color catalogue will be published by JRP Ringier for the exhibition, and will feature interviews with the artists, images, a work of fiction, and a conversation between Adel Abdessemed, Marc Blondeau, and Marc Jancou. A panel discussion will be held at the Musée d'Art Moderne et Contemporain (MAMCO) in Geneva on Wednesday, March 12th and will include Steven Claydon, Justin Lieberman, Jim Shaw, and Anj Smith.
